# FOOD SECURE CANADA

Food Secure Canada/Sécurité Alimentaire Canada (FSC-SAC) is a Canada-wide alliance of civil society organizations and individuals collaborating to advance dialogue and cooperation for policies and programs that improve food security in Canada and globally. It is based on a commitment to three interlocking goals: Zero hunger, Healthy and safe food, and Sustainable food production and distribution systems.

Since its foundation in 2006, Food Secure Canada has provided information and inspiration through its biennial Assemblies and regular communications. It also operates an on-line, open-access database on food issues called Bits and Bytes.

It currently has working groups on urban agriculture, international issues, and Northern food security, and is working with member groups on a New Farmer initiative and a Child Nutrition initiative. Its leadership is drawn from every region and sector, including fisheries, food banks, health professions, and Indigenous peoples, and it strives to work in both official languages.
